Rea Valley Fire Protection District purchases two fire trucks for service. Ken Kenny, fire chief, submitted and was awarded a grant of twenty-five thousand dollars \$25,000 from the Northwest Arkansas Economic Development District at the request of Congressman Kelley Linck. This grant was to improve the fire fighting capabilities of the fire department. These funds along with insurance benefits from a damaged fire truck were used to purchase a 1995 E-One Typhoon Fire Engine and a 2000 E-One Hurricane Fire Engine. This will greatly improve our equipment to fight fires in our community.
